

The Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) has issued the following web notices:

1. DSP-119 forms may now only be used to amend DSP85 licenses. To amend a DSP-5, DSP-61 or DSP-73 license, the applicant must submit the companion amendment form via DTRADE-2.
2. **Effective September 30, 2009**, the new Commodity Jurisdiction (CJ) form, DS-4076, is available for use. Applicants have the option of using the DS-4076 or continuing to prepare letter-type submissions. The DS-4076 will be processed as a paper document, similar to the current letter-type submissions, with appropriate attachments and copies. At a future date, the DS-4076 will go electronic and at the time, all CJs will be submitted using the DS-4076 electronically. Do not send the DS-4076 via email or on a CD at this time as it will not be accepted. A future announcement will be made when they are able to accept the new form electronically.
3. **Beginning October 19, 2009**, DDTC will allow all U.S. applicants to submit agreements electronically via the D-Trade 2 application.
