



TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION TO GO TO 100% CARGO SCREENING AUGUST 1, 2010

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) is set to do 100% cargo screening for all cargo loaded on passenger aircraft starting August 1st, 2010. These screening requirements will be phased in, with a 75% air cargo screening requirement going into effect on May 1, 2010. The TSA is currently establishing a system to ensure 100% program success.
